US FCC Seeks Input on NextNav's Proposal for 900 MHz Band Reconfiguration and Terrestrial PNT Network

The United States Federal Communications Commission (FCC) is requesting public comments on a petition by NextNav Inc. concerning a proposed reconfiguration of the 902-928 MHz band (Lower 900 MHz Band). NextNav's petition aims to transform the band to support a 5G terrestrial Positioning, Navigation, and Timing (PNT) network, which would complement the U.S. Global Positioning System (GPS).

NextNav proposes a spectrum "swap" to consolidate its current licenses into a single nationwide 15-megahertz license. The proposal includes shifting current users of the band, such as Location and Monitoring Service (LMS) licensees, and adjusting rules to

support a new Terrestrial Positioning, Navigation, and Timing Service (TPNT).

AIM Global, AIM North America, and the RAIN Alliance have formulated a joint response to refuse this proposal which includes real world impacts should this proposal be approved; severely impacting RAIN RFID deployments both in the US and globally including retail, healthcare, baggage handling, to name a few. Key issues for comment include:

- The feasibility and impact of the proposed PNT system as a GPS backup.
- Potential improvements in wireless E911 location accuracy and public safety benefits.
- Protection and relocation plans for existing band incumbents, including federal users, ISM equipment, amateur radio, and part 15 devices.
- The implications of the spectrum swap and increased flexibility on current license conditions and commercial opportunities.

Comments are due by September 5, 2024 and can be submitted here.




