RFID-Based Clothing Room Solution at University Hospital Graz

In cooperation with KAGes-Textilservice, University Hospital Graz deployed a pilot project for an RFID laundry room solution by Deister electronic in 2020. The goal: To provide hospital staff with workwear 24/7 and optimize laundry logistics. Since then, 3 clothing rooms have been deployed. By 2026, 5,500 employees are to be provided with RFID-tagged laundry in a total of at least 6 clothing rooms.
